

NASCAR POWERBALL – THE CHASE TO \$1 MILLION PROMOTION (2026)

Entry Guidelines:

1. Each Rhode Island Lottery Powerball® ticket purchased from 5:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 21, 2026, through 9:50 p.m. on Wednesday, July 22, 2026 (“Promotional Period”) from a Rhode Island Lottery Retailer, will include a Second Chance Code eligible for entry into the NASCAR® Powerball® - The Chase to \$1 Million Promotion (“Promotion”).
2. Only registered Rhode Island Lottery VIP Club members with Standard level and Plus level memberships (“VIP Members”) are eligible to enter this Promotion. VIP Club registration is free, and individuals eighteen (18) years of age or older must visit <https://www.rilot.com/en-us/registration.html> or download the Rhode Island Lottery mobile app to create a VIP Club account. VIP Club members with a Lite level membership can upgrade their account to a Standard or Plus level membership by logging in to their account and clicking “Upgrade.”
3. Eligible VIP Members will need to purchase a Powerball® ticket in Rhode Island during the Promotional Period and then log into their account and enter the twenty-three (23)-character Second Chance Code printed on the eligible ticket in the Entry Box for this Promotion. Alternatively, eligible VIP Members can log into their account using the Rhode Island Lottery mobile app and scan the QR code from the front of the eligible ticket to enter.
4. Each eligible entry will receive a corresponding number of entries into the Rhode Island Semi-Finalist Drawing for this Promotion. The number of entries a VIP Member will receive per Second Chance Code entered is dependent upon the dollar value of the Powerball® ticket purchased, i.e. a two-dollar (\$2) ticket will receive two (2) entries, except for Powerball® tickets purchased on Sunday, May 24, 2026; Sunday, May 31, 2026; Sunday, June 21, 2026; and Sunday, July 19, 2026, (each a “Bonus Day”). Powerball® tickets purchased on a Bonus Day will receive double the number of corresponding entries to the dollar value of the ticket purchased.
5. There is a Second Chance entry cap of five hundred (500) entries per day per VIP Member.
6. Each Second Chance Code may be entered into the Promotion only one (1) time.
7. Only entries submitted online through the Rhode Island Lottery website or mobile app are eligible to win. No other method of entry will be accepted.
8. The deadline to submit entries is 11:59:59 p.m. on Thursday, July 23, 2026.
9. Rhode Island Lottery employees, vendors, retailers, and anyone else deemed ineligible by the Rhode Island Lottery are prohibited from entering this Promotion. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, officers, directors, members, managers, agents, assigns, successors, employees, and contractors of National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing, LLAC, Homestead-Miami Speedway, LLC, NASCAR Enterprises, LLC, Multi-State Lottery Association, Participating Lotteries, and each of their respective parent, subsidiary, shareholders, and/or affiliated entities (collectively, “Released Parties”) and members of the immediate family (e.g., parents, spouse, children, siblings, grandparents, stepparents, stepchildren, and stepsiblings and their respective spouses, regardless of

Drawings & Winners:

A. Rhode Island Semi-Finalist Drawing

1. One drawing will be conducted on Friday, July 24, 2026, from the total number of Rhode Island Lottery eligible entries for: (i) one (1) Runner-Up winner to receive a prize of one thousand dollars (\$1,000); (ii) two (2) Runner-Up winners to each receive a prize of one thousand five hundred dollar (\$1,500); and (iii) one (1) RI Semi-finalist Winner to receive a prize of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) and be entered into the initial Multi-State Drawing conducted on Wednesday, September 9, 2026, to select a pool of twenty (20) National Semi-Finalists (as described in greater detail below), which will be announced on Sunday, September 27, 2026, at Kansas Motor Speedway in Kansas City, KS.
2. The Entry period is Thursday, May 21, 2026, at 5:00 a.m. through Thursday, July 23, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. The deadline to claim a prize is 4:00 p.m. on Friday, July 31, 2026.
3. The RI Semi-Finalist Winner and Runner-Up winners will be contacted by e-mail, telephone, and/or through a Second Chance notification within twenty-four (24) hours of the drawing date. Please be sure your VIP Club member account is updated with your latest contact information.

4. Each prize awarded in the Rhode Island Semi-Finalist Drawing must be claimed at Rhode Island Lottery Headquarters by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, July 31, 2026, or the prize will be forfeited. Alternates may be drawn.
5. In order to validate a win and claim the prize, each Rhode Island Lottery Winner must provide a copy of a valid, government-issued photo I.D., provide proof of their Social Security Number or complete and sign an IRS W-9 form, and fully complete and sign all Rhode Island Lottery claim forms.

B. Multi-State Drawing(s)

1. The RI Semi-Finalist Winner may be entered for a chance to win additional cash prizes and the Trip Prize (as described below) via Multi-State Drawings. The initial Multi-State Drawing will occur on Wednesday, September 9, 2026, where a total of twenty (20) Multi-State Semifinalists will be drawn from a national pool of entrants from all participating Lotteries for this Promotion to win an additional three thousand dollars (\$3,000) and advance to the next drawing.

3. All winners in the RI Semi-Finalist Drawing will be reviewed for debt owed to the State of Rhode Island. If such winner is identified as having an outstanding debt to a Rhode

Island State Agency or child support collected through a court, the debt must be satisfied by such winner.

4. Trip Prize Description:

The Trip Prize consists of a four (4)-day, three (3)-night VIP trip for the entry selected from a pool of Participating Lotteries' entrants (each a Finalist or collectively "Finalists") and one (1) guest to Miami, FL, from approximately Friday, November 6, 2026 to Monday, November 9, 2026, to participate in a drawing for a prize in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) ("1 Million Prize") to be conducted Sunday, November 8, 2026 during the live television broadcast of the NASCAR Cup Series Championship™ Race on NBC ("Program") from Homestead-Miami Speedway, Homestead, FL. - Two (2) passes for VIP Experiences at Homestead-Miami Speedway during NASCAR Championship Weekend™ for Saturday, November 7 and Sunday, November 8, 2026, including:
 - NASCAR Cup Series™ garage pass
 - NASCAR team hauler tour
 - MRN Radio booth tour
 - Pace car rides
 - Pre-Race attendance
 - Victory Lane access
- Two (2) Official NASCAR Championship Weekend™ Event Programs;

- Two (2) Souvenir Gift Bags, each with a retail value of at least two hundred fifty dollars (\$250);
- All meals while in Florida
- Ground transportation to and from airports, hotel, and activities in Florida

Finalists are not required to travel to Florida to participate in the drawing for, and remain eligible to win, the \$1 Million Prize. Finalists may appoint a proxy and provide contact information for the proxy, on or before October 22, 2026, to take the trip instead, subject to the Trip Prize Terms and Conditions, but will still remain eligible to win the \$1 Million Prize.

- Finalist (or their proxy) may also have the opportunity to participate in the recording and production of the Program and/or appear in the broadcast of the Program, provided that Finalist completes and signs all required releases and forms and consents to a background check.
